They will call you back. **Do not always have openings.**

GA can be a good location for rent or utility assistance, however they can be difficult to qualify for. If you are receiving assistance from any other government program, you will not qualify. You cannot be receiving FIP, Social Security, unemployment, a Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher or live in income based housing, nor can you be a college student receiving financial aid. If you have worked in the last 30 days and were fired or quit you may not be eligible. In the last 30 days your earnings must be under \$1,041 as a single person and under \$1,409 for two or more people. If you meet the above guidelines, you could receive up to \$450 two times in twelve months. If you are applying for Social Security and are unable to work, they may provide ongoing assistance. **Need Social Security Card & ID to apply.**
